## January is National Stalking Awareness, Human Trafficking and Modern Slavery Prevention Month

**Human trafficking is a global problem**. It is one of the world's most shameful crimes, and it affects the lives of millions of people around the world.

The three most common types of trafficking are **sex trafficking**, **forced labor**, and **debt bondage**. Forced Labor is also known as **involuntary servitude**, the biggest sector of trafficking in the world, according to the U.S. Department of State.

**Stalking** can be defined as the willful and repeated following, watching, or harassing of another person. Unlike other crimes, which usually involve an act, stalking is a series of actions that occur over a period of time. Stalking by an intimate partner is the most dangerous type of stalking. Four out of five stalking victims are women.

## Signs of Human and Sex Trafficking

- Fearful and mistrusting
- Cannot buy their own food or clothes
- Cannot come and go freely
- No contact with relatives or friends
- Malnourished

- Has scarring, cigarette burns, or tattoos/branding
- Signs of substance abuse or addiction
- Has traumatic brain injury, post-traumatic stress disorder, or is anxious or depressed
