ABOUT US

The Valdez Native Tribe (VNT) is located in Valdez, Alaska, in Prince William Sound approximately 300 miles from Anchorage. For the Alaskan Native people of this region, Valdez was historically a favorite place to hunt, fish, gather, and trade. Today the VNT, formed in 1974, as a 501c3 non-profit, is the Tribal organization for the local Native community that provides culturally relevant, health, social, and educational services to any Alaska Native or American Indian living in the Valdez service area. Currently, there are over 800 individuals from 190 households who, proudly, call the VNT their tribe.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Before going in for any services, there is very important information that needs to be mentioned so you're not left with an unpaid bill:

- Emergency Room visits are to prevent loss of life or limb. If you have a non-emergency need for medical care, please call for an appointment in the Clinic for the next business day.
- We don't deny medical care but **may** deny payment.
- Public Health visits, hearing tests, as well as developmental testing are not paid for. The Public Health office is in the Mary K. Gilson Clinic Building. Please call 907-835-4612 for an appointment.
- Failure to get an authorization may result in a denial of payment.
